2.5_1 Defect List for Restaurant Textiles

The three types of defects defined:

Critical Defect - A defect that is likely to result in a hazardous or unsafe condition for an individual or anyone around him using the product or that contravenes mandatory regulations.

Tolerance limits for defect (size, repeatability, quality, significance) will be defined later.

Major Defect – A defect that is likely to result in failure; reducing the usability of the product and obvious appearance defects affecting the sale ability or shorten the life cycle of the product.

Tolerance limits of defects (size, repeatability, quality, significance) will be defined later.

4 Major defects = 1 critical defect

Minor Defect – A defect that does not reduce the usability of the product but is nevertheless a workmanship defect beyond the defined specifications or construction requirements.

Tolerance limits for defect (size, repeatability, quality, significance) will be defined later.

4 Minor defects = 1 Major Defect.

Please note that the list below is not all inclusive, and there might be other variables to check depending on the type of product.
