Kevlar®, Twaron), acrylic, antistatic fibres (Negastat®), elastane as well as their blends, undyed, bleached, pigment spun dyed and/or reactive, vat, cationic, acid and/or disperse yarn or piece dyed, partly with water & oil repellent finishing as well as fabric for roll towels made of cotton or cotton/polyester, bleached or reactive or vat, yarn or piece dyed; partly finished with flame retardant products accepted by OEKO-TEX®, partly produced with fibres accepted by OEKO-TEX® having flame retardant properties; produced using components partly pre-certified according to OEKO-TEX® STANDARD 100.

Note: Various tested acrylic fibres or aramid fibres may contain more than 0,1% (but max. 3.0 %) of DMAc (Dimethylacetamide) and have to undergo further industrial production stages (heat process in wet or dry stage is ... [Please scan QR code for full scope]
